- Wittler reviewed the discussion at the recent planning retreat.
- J. Schwartz was asked to get an updated cost estimate for repaving the private streets so we could consider whether this is the right time to propose repaving again.
- The annual meeting will be hybrid with in-person meeting at Firefighter's Hall. Osborn will check with the Hall manager about wifi and internet capacity. Election Buddy software will again be used for remote voting. Allison Zach, UNL Invasive Species Program Coordinator will be invited to make a short presentation on the zebra mussels threat to the lake.

- Wittler to gather information for remote control access to boat ramp lock and video.
- Wittler will revise proposed budget and circulate before December meeting.
- We will make a concerted effort next spring to address deficient docks.
